**NEWS TO KNOW****NCARB Launches e-EVR Online Reporting System**

Effective December 31, 2008

The National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) has officially launched the electronic Experience Verification Reporting system (e-EVR) on December 31, 2008. Interns are able to report their experience for the Intern Development Program (IDP) online through "My NCARB Record" instead of sending in paper forms. Electronic submissions will replace paper submissions as the standard way interns submit experience reports to complete the IDP. Interns are strongly encouraged to use the e-EVR. **New Sustainable Design Continuing Education Requirement**

Effective January 1, 2009

Beginning in 2009, of the total 18 CES Learning Units (LUs) required in a given calendar year four (4) LUs are required to focus on sustainable design and meet the established guidelines for sustainable design mandatory continuing education. [More information](#)

**Please note the last date to test ARE 3.1 divisions is June 30, 2009.** The last date to attempt to schedule an ARE 3.1 appointment is June 27, 2009.
